Report to the NZMS Annual General Meeting, 2020

There are two major changes to report this year. The first one is that Shaun Cooper resigned for personal reasons as Editor for the journal, after the excellent care of many years. I would like to thank him for all his effort and care for the journal as Editor. He has done a lot for the journal. The NZJM Committee was very pleased that Charles Semple agreed to be the new Editor. The second major change is that the journal transformed from an email based system to an editorial management system. This was initiated by Shaun Cooper. With the help of Mark Wilson, Shaun Cooper and Charles Semple the new website for the journal is
